9	Are public ROW trees included?	9	ROW trees on roads will be included in the project. Right of Way trees may be included in the program, at the direction and sole discretion of the IMT.
33	Will chipping of trees back onto the properties be allowed? If so at what depth?	33	Refer to Exhibit A.1 Section 8.8.3 on pages 81-82-84. If directed by the IMT, the DDHTR Contractor will place no more than two to three inches of chipped wood slash on all areas greater than one hundred contiguous square feet where the soil has been disturbed by the DDHTR Contractor's hazard tree removal operation. Refer to Exhibit A: Scope of Work, Section 7.2.2.2. If wood chips are used, the depth shall not exceed two to three inches.
