Project Summary: An unpaved section of a county road, Sherwood Road, running through timberland east of the city of Fort Bragg, has become the target of serious illegal roadside dumping including numerous vehicles, tires, appliances, and household trash. The property owner has requested assistance. The trash is a public nuisance, environmental hazard and public safety threat. This project would remove the vehicles and trash, recycle all materials possible, and erect 1000` of wire fencing and post no dumping signs to discourage future dumping. The work will be done by experienced personnel of the Mendocino Solid Waste Management Authority, assisted by a vehicle towing contractor assigned by the County of Mendocino Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Program.

Mr. Ken Brady, co-owner of the properties, without knowledge of this grant program, took it upon himself to remove and properly dispose of all of the refuse. His actions make him eligible for reimbursement consideration .
