21	EDDIE L. WILLIAMS, d.b.a. WILLIAMS TIRE SERVICE, a.k.a. 24 HOUR		
22	TIRE (RESPONDENT) and the California Integrated Waste Management Board		
23	(CIWMB) attended a hearing at the Office of Administrative Hearings on December		
24	18, 2006, for the purpose of adjudicating an Amended Administrative Complaint for		
25	Waste Tire Hauler Penalties. The parties agreed at hearing to the terms of a		
26	settlement, and the Administrative Law Judge put the terms of that settlement in the		
27	January 20, 2007 Amended Proposed Decision issued by the Office of		
28	Administrative Hearings (attached). The Board of CIWMB approved of the terms of		
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the settlement, and therefore, on March 4, 2007, CIWMB served RESPONDENT 1  $\mathbf{2}$ with an Administrative Decision adopting the OAH Proposed Decision (CIWMB Decision). 3 FINDINGS 4 1. In accordance with the terms of the CIWMB Decision, RESPONDENT  $\mathbf{5}$ was ordered to pay an administrative penalty of \$16,000.00. The sum of 6 7 \$12,500.00 was held in abeyance for three years pending compliance with conditions of the CIWMB Decision. 8 2. Condition number four (on page two of the Amended Proposed 9 Decision) requires that RESPONDENT pay \$3,500 to CIWMB in payments of 10 \$200.00 per month, due and payable the first day of each month, beginning on 11 March 1, 2007. 12 3. RESPONDENT made one payment of \$200.00 on March 27, 2007, 13 and failed to make further payments. 14 On May 23, 2007, CIWMB sent a Notice of Default by certified mail to 15 4. RESPONDENT. Subsequently, RESPONDENT requested a waiver of monthly 16 payments until September 2007. 17On June 13, 2007, CIWMB sent a certified letter notifying 5. 18 RESPONDENT of CIWMB's approval of RESPONDENT'S request for a waiver of 19 monthly payments until September 2007. The June 13, 2007, CIWMB letter also 20 advised that: 21 a. If RESPONDENT failed to remit payment within five days of the due date, 22this would result in an immediate default, 23b. RESPONDENT would not be accorded a hearing in the matter, and 24c. An Amended Administrative Decision would be issued ordering 25RESPONDENT to pay the amount of penalties currently held in abeyance 26in addition to what RESPONDENT currently owes. 27**RESPONDENT** failed to make payments in September, October and 6. 28- 2 -

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1	November and is currently three months behind in making payments.	
2	7. On November 7, 2007, CIWMB sent a Notice of Default by certified	
3	mail, and by U.S. Mail, to RESPONDENT. RESPONDENT has not responded to	
4	this Notice of Default.	
5	LEGAL CONCLUSION	
<sup>'</sup> 6	RESPONDENT failed to make payments as indicated by the terms of the	
7	CIWMB Decision. Therefore, RESPONDENT is in default of the CIWMB Decision	
8	as described at paragraph six of page four of the Amended Proposed Decision. As	
9	a result, in addition to the \$3,300 currently due the CIWMB, the stay is lifted on the	
10	\$12,500.00 in penalties that was held in abeyance, and the \$12,500.00 is also	
11	currently due and owing to the CIWMB, making the total amount owed to the	
12	CIWMB \$15,800.00.	
13		
14	ORDER	
15	The following Order is hereby made:	
16	RESPONDENT is ordered to immediately pay \$15,800.00 to the CIWMB.	
17		
18	This DECISION shall become effective December 6, 2007.
