Upcoming Public Workshop: SB 1383 Revised Draft Regulations June 18, 2019 (Diamond Bar, California)

CalRecycle will present a new revised draft of the SB 1383 Short-Lived Climate Pollutants regulations at a public workshop on June 18, 2019 in Diamond Bar, California. This workshop will also be webcast. The 15-day formal public comment period will begin the following day and run from June 19 – July 3.

The text of the revised regulation will be posted at the <u>Short-Lived Climate Pollutants</u> (<u>SLCP</u>): <u>Organic Waste Methane Emissions Reductions Information Page</u> prior to June 18th. A notice will be sent out when the language is available.
