California's recycling laws are changing in 2020 and we are trying to get the word out to all commercial property owners in the area.

Starting soon, businesses, schools, hospitals, government buildings ,multi-family dwellings (5+ units) and other commercial properties generating two cubic yards of solid waste (trash, recycling, and organics) must begin separating and recycling their organic waste (food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, nonhazardous wood waste, and food-soiled paper waste that is mixed in with food waste). Multi-family dwellings (5+ units) do not have to collect food waste and food soiled paper. For more information about the law:
