



Recycled-Content Trash Bag Program Summary of Manufacturer Compliance: 2014 Report Year

The following summary is based on Plastic Trash Bag Certifications received by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for the 2014 reporting period* and includes manufacturers that:

Compliant Manufacturers: Submitted self-certification and met the requirements of the law.

Non-Compliant Manufacturers: Submitted self-certification and claimed non-compliance.

Non-Compliant/Non-Responsive Manufacturers: Did not submit an annual certification by March 1 (and are therefore not in compliance).
