

# Mattress Recycling Program Update: Illegal Dumping

#### What is the MRC?

- In 2013, California passed SB-254 creating a statewide mattress recycling program
- Mattress Recycling Council (MRC) was created by the International Sleep Products Association (ISPA), the trade association for the mattress industry
- Non-profit with targeted task of implementing recycling laws in states with supporting legislation (CT, CA, RI)
- Certified by, and has oversight by CalRecycle

#### **Program Objectives**

- ✓ Increase number of mattresses recycled
- ✓ Effectively communicate with consumers
- ✓ Minimize consumer recycling fee & reduce public agency costs
- ✓ Prevent and reduce illegal dumping

# **Program Implementation**

- Began Dec. 30, 2015
- Funding: \$11.00 per unit fee on mattresses and box springs
- Over 100 Collection locations in CA SWF & Retail
- One-day collection events
- 11 primary recycler locations
- Over 300,000 mattresses collected to date

## **Illegal Dumping: Prevention**

- No cost retailer pick-up from consumer
- No cost drop off at collection locations
- Consumer incentive at recycling facilities

# Illegal Dumping Payment Program (IDPP)

- Offset costs to clean-up illegally dumped mattresses
- Reimburse up to \$10 per mattress collected
- \$750,000 for 2016
- Data collected will establish baseline

### **IDPP: Eligibility & Registration**

#### **Eligible Entities**

- Local Government
- Solid Waste Facilities
- Franchise haulers
- Non-profits contracted w/ municipalities
- JPA's
- Tribes

#### **IDPP: Reporting Requirements**

Each pick-up requires data entry of:

- # of units collected
- Zip code
- End disposition of units: Recycled or landfilled

- MRC Program Updates
- Email blasts to participating entities
- CalRecycle distribution
- Presentations

## **IDPP: Implementation**

- 54 registered to date
- Over 2,500 mattresses reported to date
- Continued growth
- Participants paid after Calendar Year
   \$750,000/# of units = \$ per unit paid
- Continually evaluate program effectiveness

- Expand Collection Network
   SWF's, Retail locations, innovative solutions for rural
   communities
- Expand Illegal Dumping Payment Program
- Improve consumer outreach locator tool
