Re: CalRecycle Determination of Completeness of PaintCare's 2017 California Paint Stewardship Program Annual Report

Dear Jeremy,

The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) received PaintCare's 2017 California Paint Stewardship Program Annual Report on November 2, 2017. California Code of Regulations (CCR) Title 14, Division 7, Chapter 11, Article 2, Section 18952(c)(2) requires CalRecycle to determine if the report is complete and notify PaintCare within 30 days.

Staff reviewed the report for completeness within the context of the requirements in statute (Public Resources Code [PRC] §48700-48706) and the CCR and found PaintCare's Annual Report to be complete.

With respect to its compliance review, CalRecycle has 90 days (until January 31, 2018) in which to review the report and overall program for compliance with PRC §48700-48706 and 14 CCR §18950-18957 and adopt a finding of compliance, non-compliance, or conditional approval. Staff will present an analysis and recommendation regarding program compliance for the director's consideration at CalRecycle's monthly public meeting on January 23, 2018.

CalRecycle has requested stakeholder input by December 8, 2017, so that comments can be considered during staffs' compliance review.
