## **CRV Computations**

For questions about California Redemption Value (CRV) computations, please call the Dealer Message Line with the Dealer Management Unit at (916) 322-0195.

- California Redemption Value (CRV) is a regulatory fee collected for the purpose of assuring the return for recycling of a greater percentage of the beverage containers sold in this state.
- CRV is subject to sales tax only if the sale of the beverage is subject to sales tax.
- The following table is designed to assist dealers in determining CRV charges for applicable containers sold as singles, 6 packs, 12 packs, etc. Dealers in unserved zones that are required to redeem empty beverage containers in their stores should buy back containers according to this table.

**Public Resources Code Section 14504** defines "beverage" as any of the following products if those products are in **liquid, ready-to-drink** form, and are **intended for human consumption**:

- Beer and other malt beverages
- Wine (effective January 1, 2024)
- Distilled Spirits (effective January 1, 2024)
- Wine and distilled spirit coolers in any ABV (effective January 1, 2024)
- Carbonated water, including soda and carbonated mineral water
- Noncarbonated water, including noncarbonated mineral water
- Carbonated soft drinks
- Noncarbonated soft drinks and "sport" drinks
- Noncarbonated fruit drinks that contain any percentage of fruit juice
- Coffee and tea drinks
- Carbonated fruit drinks
- Vegetable juice in beverage containers in all sizes (effective January 1, 2024)
- 100 percent fruit juice in containers in all sizes (effective January 1, 2024)

The following are some of the common **non-CRV** items on which **CRV** should **NOT** be charged:

- Products not intended for human consumption
- Products not in liquid or ready-to-drink form
- Beverages in containers not made of aluminum, glass, plastic or bimetal
  - Except Wine, Distilled Spirits and Cooler in Box, Bladder or Pouch (effective January 1, 2024)
- Milk
- Medical food
- Infant formula
