Re: Mattress Recycling Council Annual Report Completeness Review

Dear Mr. Trainer,

The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) received the Mattress Recycling Council's (MRC) 2018 Annual Report on July 1, 2019. The California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 14, § 18964(c) requires CalRecycle to determine if the Annual Report is complete and notify the MRC of its determination within 30 days of receipt.

Staff reviewed the Annual Report for completeness per the requirements in the Public Resources Code (PRC) §§ 42985-42994 and CCR §§ 18959-18971, and found MRC's Annual Report to be complete.

CalRecycle has 60 days (until August 30, 2019) to review the Annual Report and MRC's program for compliance with the requirements in statute and regulations and adopt a finding of compliance, non-compliance, or conditional approval. Staff will present an analysis and recommendation regarding program compliance for the director's consideration at the department's monthly public meeting on August 20, 2019.
