

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION
FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION OF THE
TEHAMA COUNTY SANITARY LANDFILL AGENCY
RECYCLING MARKET DEVELOPMENT ZONE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that the Tehama County Sanitary Landfill Agency ("TCSLA") acting in its official capacity, intends to adopt a Negative Declaration, prepared pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA;" Public Resources Code Section 21000, et seq.), for the proposed TCSLA Recycling Market Development Zone ("RMDZ").

Project Description: The project is the creation of a zone incorporating the County of Tehama, under the RMDZ program. The RMDZ program is an economic and technical assistance program which includes a low interest loan program available to manufacturers within the RMDZ that make products from recycled materials.

Document Availability: Documents comprising the Initial Study and Negative Declaration will be available for review by the general public between normal business hours (M-F: 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and weekends: 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.) at the Tehama County Sanitary Landfill Agency, located at 19995 Plymire Road, Red Bluff, California, 96080. Public Review Period: The Initial Study and Negative Declaration, and all documents referenced therein, will be available for public review and comment for a 20-day period, beginning on Thursday, November 12, 2009, and ending on Tuesday, December 1, 2009.
