### Notice of Preparation of Environmental Impact Report for the adoption of Regulations to Implement SB 1383 – Short-lived Climate Pollutants (SLCP) Organic Waste Methane Emission Reduction Requirements

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) staff will hold a California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) scoping meeting to discuss the Notice of Preparation (SCH# 2018122023) for an Environmental Impact Report for the Adoption of Regulations to Implement SB 1383.

Responsible and trustee agencies as well as members of the public are invited to participate in the meeting. The purpose of the scoping meeting is to discuss the Notice of Preparation and seek comments and input from members of the public and responsible and trustee agencies on the EIR to determine the scope of the environmental assessment for the project.

#### **Background:**

CalRecycle will prepare and circulate an EIR to disclose potential significant adverse effects on the environment as a result of the planned adoption of the SB 1383 Regulations. The results of the EIR will disclose information on potential significant impacts and mitigation measures, and is expected to assist state and local agencies with information for future site-specific CEQA reviews that may be required for new or expanding local projects that may directly or indirectly result from the SB 1383 regulations.

On December 11, 2018, CalRecycle staff filed a Notice of Preparation with the Office of Planning and Research (OPR) to request comments as to the scope and contents of the EIR, including mitigation measures or project alternatives to reduce potential significant environmental impacts from the

**Purpose of the Public Meeting:**

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the NOP and to provide responsible and trustee agencies and the public an opportunity to provide comments on the appropriate scope and content of the proposed environmental analysis, potential significant impacts that should be considered and disclosed, and mitigation measures.

CalRecycle staff will solicit oral comments at the workshop. Additionally, if stakeholders wish to submit written comments regarding the potential significant environmental impact issues, please submit the written comments **on or before January 10, 2019**. To submit written comments, please see the section entitled "How to Submit Written Comments" below. CalRecycle staff will not prepare written responses to each individual comment received, but will consider comments during the development of the EIR.

*The purpose of this meeting is not to discuss the policy proposed in the proposed regulatory text for the SB 1383 regulations. This public meeting is not a formal hearing on the draft SB 1383 regulations. Additionally, the comment deadline in this notice is the deadline for comments on the NOP. This is not the deadline for comments on the proposed regulatory text. The Notice of Proposed Action (NOPA), the formal hearing date for comments on the SB 1383 regulations, and the deadline for submitting written comments on the proposed regulatory text will be announced in a subsequent notice via the SB 1383 listserv.*

All interested parties, including representatives responsible and trustee agencies, municipalities and other public agencies/entities, representatives of environmental groups, and all other individuals interested in environmental assessment for this project.
