WHY RECYCLED PAINT?

- Save Money \$\$\$
- Quality Assured
- Reduce energy consumption
- Conserve water
- Reduce use of raw materials & waste
- Generate less pollution
- Support domestic recycling markets
- Environmentally Preferable Purchase (EPP)
- SABRC compliant
 - >50% post-consumer recycled content





SABRC REQUIREMENTS



- Paint is one of 11 State Agency Buy Recycled Campaign (SABRC) categories
- 50% of dollars spent on paint, must be spent on recycled paint
 - >50% post-consumer minimum content requirement (all CA recycled paints meet req.)
 - Ex: Buy 1 gal recycled paint (\$10) + 1 gal standard paint (\$30) \rightarrow \$40 reportable dollars
 - \$10 of \$40 reportable dollars are SABRC compliant= 25% compliance
- SABRC Annual Report- Summarize recycled product purchases to meet mandates of PCC §12200-12217

STATE CONTRACT

- Mandatory Contract w/ Visions
- New Contract #1-16-80-10
- Recycled Latex Paint
 - Now includes semi-gloss
 - Custom colors available
 - Minimum order- 4 gallons
 - Quality Assured
 - Cost is \$6.50/gallon and up
- SABRC/EPP compliant

RECYCLE LEFTOVER PAINT

- PaintCare program started Oct. 2012
- ■~750 free drop-off sites for leftover paint*

 - *Businesses that generate >220 lbs/month (approx. 20-30 gallons), may use program for latex paint only
- Free Large Volume Pick-up Service for 300+ gallons
