TO: All Certified Recycling Centers

SUBJECT: \$5 Million Temporary Assistance to Low-Volume Recyclers

On June 9, 2019, the Conference Committee on the Budget – AB 74, authorizes the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to expend up to \$5 million to provide temporary assistance to low-volume recyclers.

Beginning July 1, 2019 and until June 30, 2020, CalRecycle may expend up to \$5 million and issue monthly payments of \$1,000 to 416 certified recycling centers with the lowest average daily volume of beverage containers redeemed that are operational during the entire month for which the payment is made and are still operational at the time the payment is made.

To calculate the average daily volume (ADV), the department shall determine the number of beverage containers redeemed based on the reported redemption weights taken from shipping reports where the last day of the receipt and log period is within the three-month period directly preceding the month for which the supplemental payment is made. The payment schedule is below:
