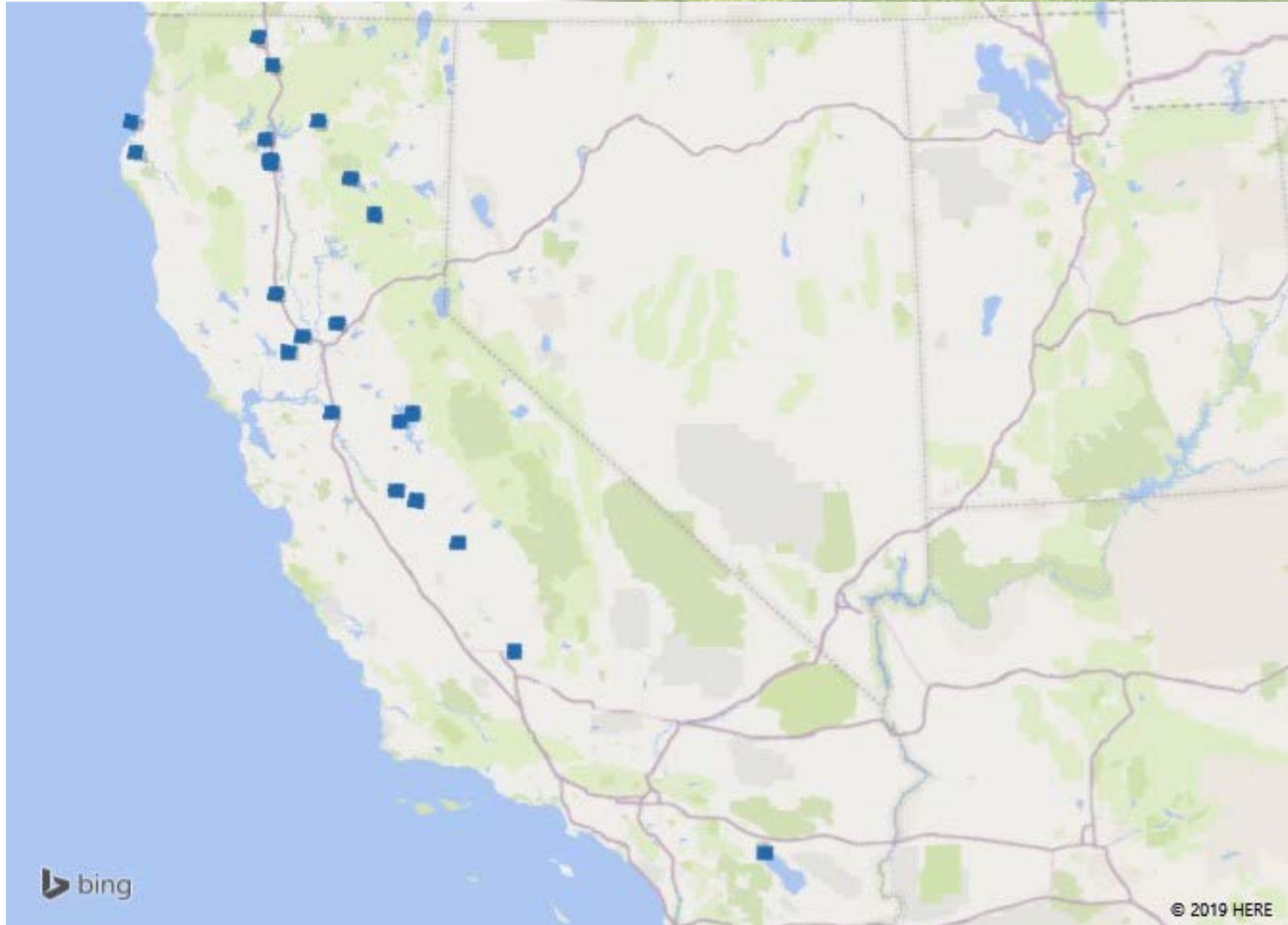

Active Biomass Conversion Facilities

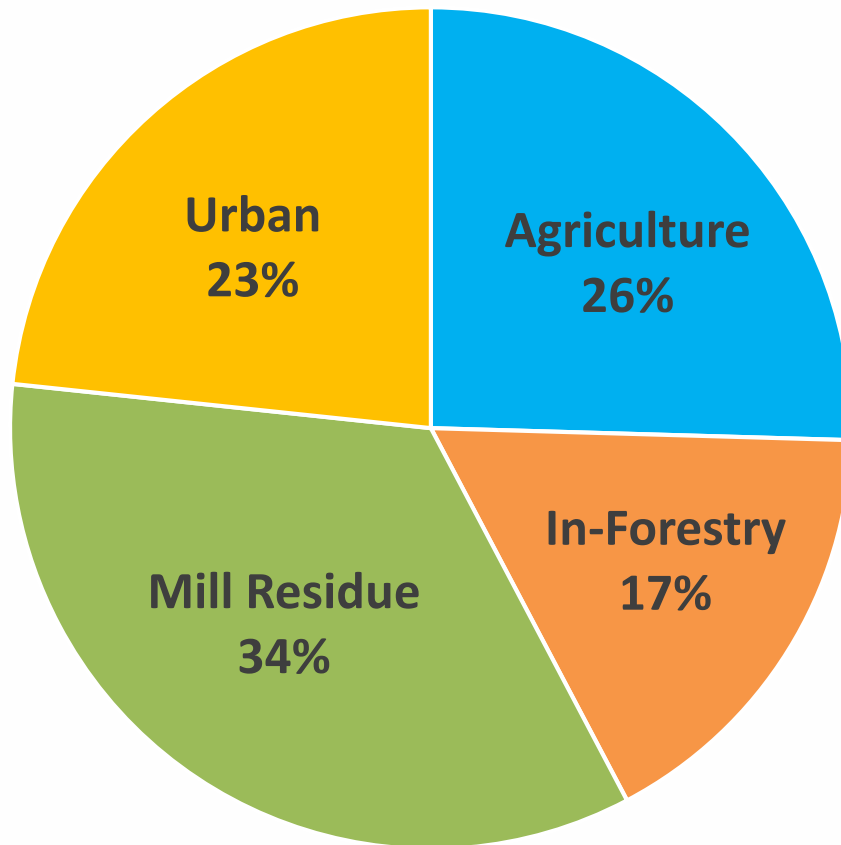

2019 Reporting Data

- All 25 active facilities submitted reports
- 4,510,696 tons accepted
- 85 tons rejected due to contamination
- All facilities sent by-products to final destinations such as dairies and landfills

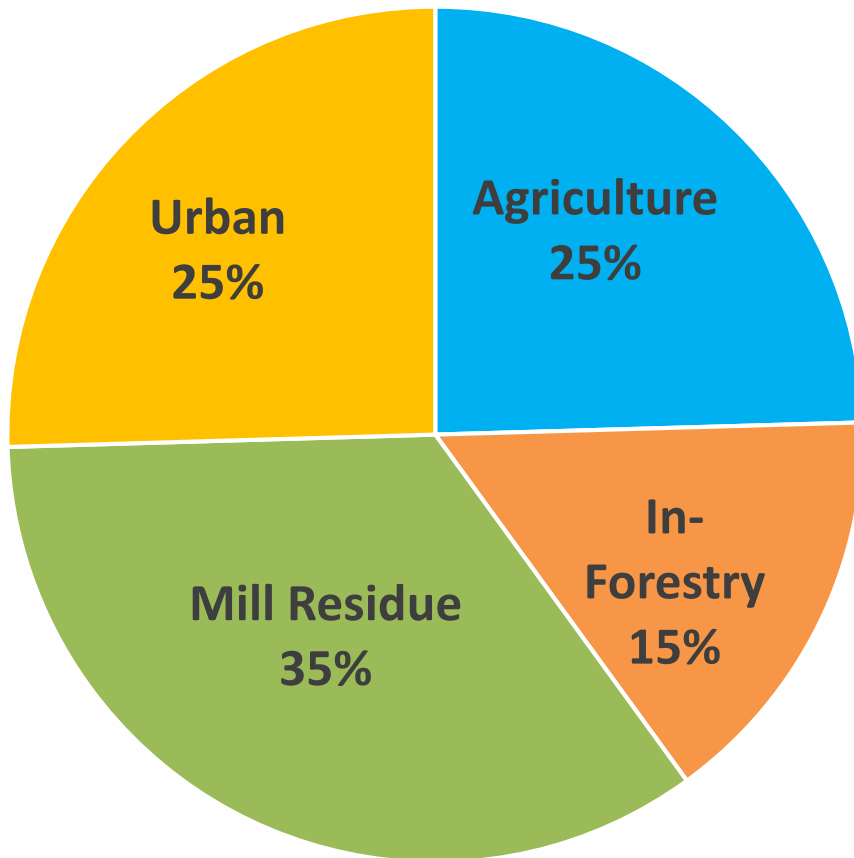

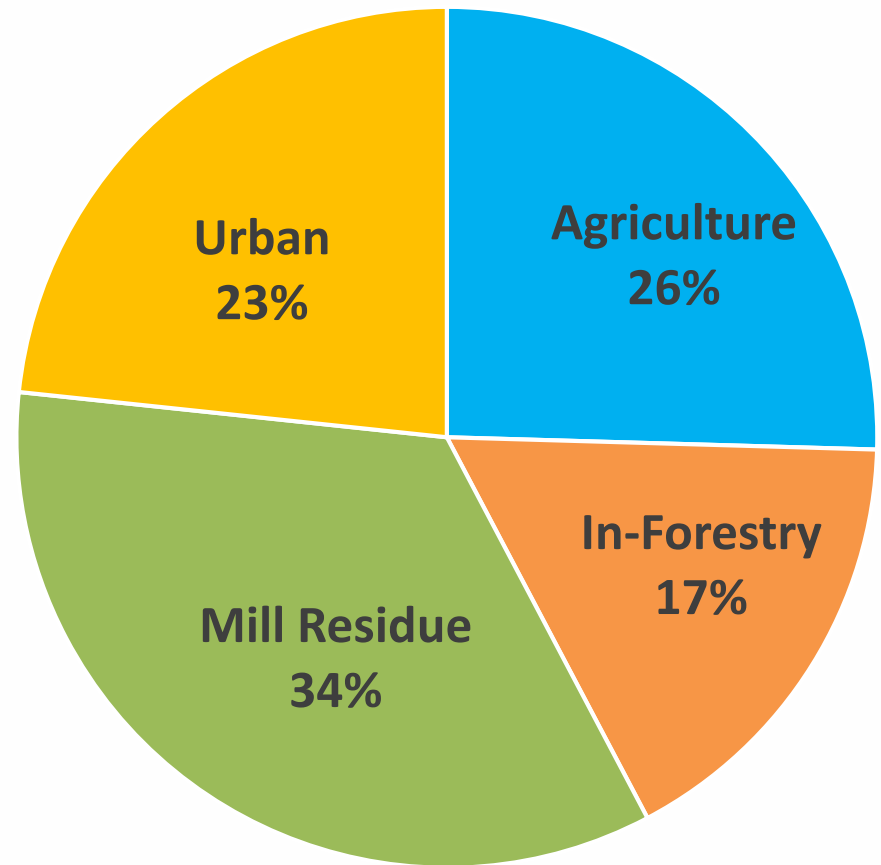

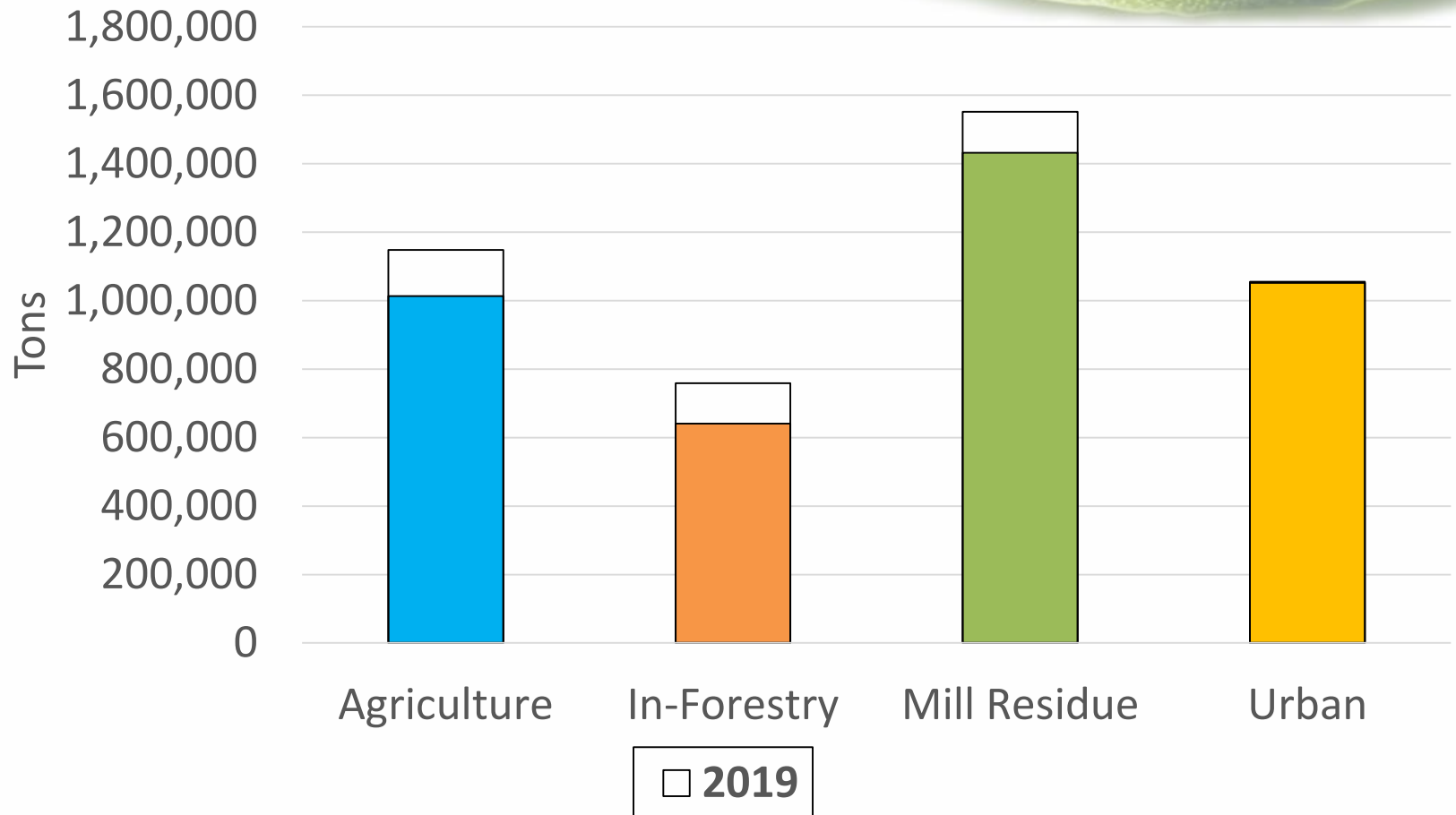

2015-2019

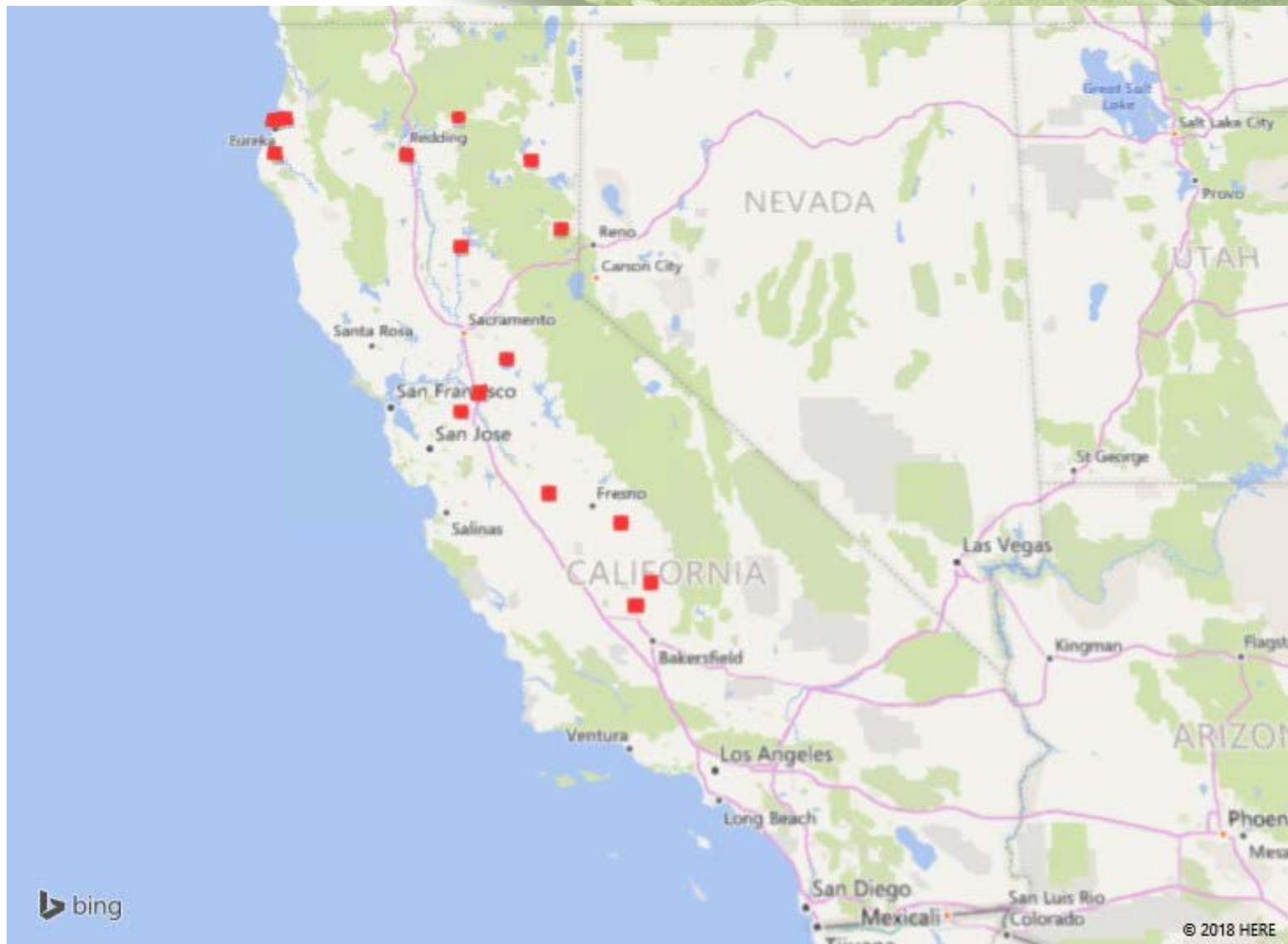
