



NOTICE OF REVISIONS TO PROPOSED RULEMAKING

PROPOSED REVISED REGULATORY ACTION

The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) proposes to revise regulations relative to Designated Approved Collectors. The proposed regulations establish and clarify requirements related to participating in the Covered Electronic Waste (CEW) Recycling Program as a Designated Approved Collector, the responsibilities and options for a Local Government that chooses to designate an approved collector, and CalRecycle's administrative responsibilities related to Designations. CalRecycle intends to adopt the proposed regulations described herein after considering all recommendations, comments, and objections regarding the proposed action.

15-DAY WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

On January 31, 2020, CalRecycle will initiate a 15-day written comment period for revisions to proposed regulations relative to Designated Approved Collectors. **The 15-day written public comment period for this rulemaking ends on February 14, 2020 at 11:59 PM.**

This 15-day comment period follows an initial 45-day public comment period that began on October 12, 2019 and ended on November 26, 2019. On November 27, 2019 CalRecycle held a public hearing to receive public comments. After considering the comments received from stakeholders, CalRecycle staff decided to make a revision in the proposed language. Specifically, Section 18660.48(b) was revised. This revision will add clarity to the existing language.
