### Emergency Waivers

Solid waste facilities may need to address changes in operations at facilities that are inconsistent with the permit when there is a declared emergency. California Governor Gavin Newsom in [Executive Order N-25-20](#) proclaimed a State of Emergency on March 12, 2020 as a result of the threat COVID-19. The threat of COVID-19 may have direct and indirect impacts to solid waste facility operations.
