NOTICE OF POSTPONEMENT - 19th Technical Training Series

California Governor Gavin Newsom in <u>Executive Order N-25-20</u> proclaimed a State of Emergency on March 12, 2020, and consistent with directives from the City of Long Beach designed to minimize the spread and mitigate the effects of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, CalRecycle has decided to postpone the 19th Technical Training Series scheduled for April 6-9, 2020 in Long Beach, CA.
