ARTICLE 2. PROCESSING FEES AND PROCESSING PAYMENTS

§ 2975. REASONABLE FINANCIAL RETURN CALCULATION. The [begin strikethrough] statewide average [end strikethrough] reasonable financial return for recycling centers shall be equal to [begin underline] 10 percent of [end underline] the statewide average allowable costs calculated in section 2960 of this subchapter [begin strikethrough], multiplied by the average return on costs for the scrap and waste materials industry as determined from data contained in the most recent Dun and Bradstreet Standard Three Year Norm Report (Published by Dun and Bradstreet Credit Services) [end strikethrough].
