Elevation Waiver Application

CalRecycle is providing this form to assist jurisdictions in applying for elevation waivers under 14 CCR 18984.12. Use of this form is optional and not a regulatory requirement.

A jurisdiction may apply to CalRecycle for a waiver from the requirement to separate and recover food waste and food-soiled paper if the entire jurisdiction is at or above an elevation of 4,500 feet or for portions of an unincorporated county with specific census tracts that are at or above an elevation of 4,500 feet. The elevation waiver can be for some or all of its residential and commercial generators located at or above 4,500 feet.

CalRecycle approved elevation waivers do not expire.

Following approval by CalRecycle, residential and commercial generators located within an area that has a waiver may deposit food waste and food-soiled paper in a disposal container. However, an approved waiver does not waive a jurisdiction from its obligation to provide a collection service that collects and recycles the other types of organic wastes specified in 14 CCR 18984.1, 18984.2, or 18984.3 in a manner that meets the requirements of those sections. Additionally, an approved elevation waiver does not waive a jurisdiction from its obligation to comply with the other requirements of the SB 1383 regulations including, but not limited to, promoting and providing information to generators about waste prevention, community composting, and managing organic waste on site.
