

Non-Local Entity Waiver Application

CalRecycle is providing this form as a convenience to assist non-local entities in applying for a waiver under 14 CCR 18986.3. Use of this form is optional and not a regulatory requirement.

A non-local entity may apply to CalRecycle for a waiver from some or all of the organic waste collection services requirements of Article 5. A non-local entity may apply for a waiver based on inadequate space, total amount of organic waste generated, and/or the non-local entity being located within a jurisdiction or census tract that has been granted a waiver by CalRecycle as specified in 14 CCR 18984.12.

The non-local entity may use this resource tool along with the submission of documentation demonstrating and supporting the waiver request as specified in 14 CCR 18986.3.

CalRecycle-approved waivers are valid for a period of up to five years.

Nothing in 14 CCR 18986.1 prohibits a non-local entity from preventing waste generation, managing organic waste on site, or using a community-composting site.
