Subject: Enforcement Advisory Council Resolution 2021-04 – Revision to Council Meeting Procedures

Dear Mr. de Bie:

On August 25, 2021, the Enforcement Advisory Council (EAC) voted to approve a revision to the council's meeting procedures. Specifically, the EAC requested an update in the language regarding meeting frequency and venue.

Currently, the council's structure and procedures state meetings will occur six times per year. Since 2009, the EAC has met an average of four times per year. The update to the EAC's procedures will more accurately reflect the council's meeting frequency over the last decade while continuing to allow it to convene as often as necessary, ensuring continued communication between LEA and CalRecycle staff between regional LEA roundtables.

Throughout 2020, the EAC has met entirely in a virtual format to accommodate travel restrictions due to COVID-19 impacts. Virtual meetings have been successful and have reduced travel time and expenditures on the part of EAC representatives. Going forward and as travel restrictions continue to be lifted, a combination of traditional and virtual meetings will be utilized.

Therefore, the EAC respectfully requests that CalRecycle recognize the change in meeting procedures associated with the Enforcement Advisory Council.
