CalEPA October 2021 Public (Online) Workshops on Identification of Disadvantaged Communities

The California Environmental Protection Agency (CalEPA) is holding two virtual public workshops to discuss the draft proposed update to its designation of disadvantaged communities. Senate Bill (SB) 535 directs CalEPA to identify disadvantaged communities for the purposes of targeting a portion of investments within the California Climate Investments program, which is funded by Cap-and-Trade auction proceeds.

CalEPA, with support from the California Air Resources Board (CARB) and Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA), is hosting the following two identical workshops to receive feedback on how disadvantaged communities should be identified in California. The workshops will begin with a welcome and brief presentation on CalEPA's proposal and CalEnviroScreen 4.0, then staff from State agencies will convene multiple breakout rooms for participants to provide input and ask questions.
