Re: CalRecycle's Completeness Determination of UltiMed's Annual Program Budget

Dear Mr. Erickson:

The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) received UltiMed, Inc's (UltiMed) annual program budget on March 31, 2022, as part of its 2021 annual report, titled, *Pharmaceutical and Sharps Waste Stewardship 2021 Annual Report.* The California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 14, section 18973.1(b) requires CalRecycle to determine if the annual program budget is complete and notify UltiMed of its determination within 30 days of receipt.

Staff reviewed UltiMed's annual program budget for completeness pursuant to the requirements in the Public Resources Code (PRC) section 42033.2(a)(2) and 42033.2(c) and CCR sections 18973.1(b) and 18973.6 and found the annual program budget incomplete. PRC sections 42033.2(a) and (a)(2) require a program operator to submit, by March 31, 2022, a written program budget for the upcoming calendar year. A program budget for calendar year 2023 is required. UltiMed submitted a program budget for calendar year 2022. Therefore, the entirety of the submitted annual program budget is incomplete. However, CalRecycle evaluated the information in the 2022 budget and is providing information, for illustrative purposes only, that UltiMed can consider when preparing its revised annual program budget (see Attachment 1).

This completeness determination is separate from the compliance determination that CalRecycle will conduct once it receives an annual program budget it determines is complete pursuant to CCR sections 18973.1(d) through (f).

UltiMed must resubmit its 2023 annual program budget to CalRecycle within 30 days of CalRecycle's notification that its annual program budget is incomplete. If CalRecycle determines, upon resubmittal, that UltiMed's 2023 annual program budget is complete, CalRecycle shall have 90 days from the date of receipt of the resubmitted annual program budget to review for compliance with all statutory and regulatory requirements and approve, conditionally approve, or disapprove the 2023 annual program budget.
