Re: CalRecycle's Completeness Determination of MED-Project's 2021 Annual Report for Covered Drugs

Dear Mr. Wilson:

The Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) received MED-Project USA's (MED-Project) 2021 annual report for covered drugs on June 1, 2022, titled, *MED-Project 2021 Annual Report, State of California, Covered Drugs*. Title 14, California Code of Regulations (14 CCR) 18973.1(b) requires CalRecycle to determine if the annual report is complete and notify MED-Project of its determination within 30 days of receipt.

Staff reviewed MED-Project's annual report for completeness pursuant to the requirements in the Public Resources Code (PRC) section 42033.2(a)(1) and 42033.2(b) and 14 CCR sections 18973.1(b) and 18973.4 and found the 2021 annual report complete. This completeness determination is separate from the compliance determination CalRecycle will now conduct (see 14 CCR sections 18973.1(d) through (f)). CalRecycle has 90 days from the date of the annual report submittal (i.e., August 30, 2022) to review for compliance with all statutory and regulatory requirements and approve, conditionally approve, or disapprove the annual report.
