SOT Chester Hopkins: "I'm 65 so I grew up here, I knew almost every family in the neighborhood. My grandfather came here in the 1920s and worked at the Mill."

Crews have removed ash and debris on the Hopkins' property. Next is testing the soil for contaminates to protect the Hopkins and others in Lincoln Heights who want to rebuild.

SOT Chester Hopkins: "This is home. ... We grew up in this neighborhood, and we've been here for all this time, so we need to come back and enjoy where we started."
