Solid Waste Technical Documents On Demand Training Now Available

CalRecycle is pleased to announce the release of the on-demand <u>Solid Waste Technical Documents</u> training. The training covers landfill closure and post-closure plans, corrective action plans, landfill gas plans, status impact reports, and available resources. The training takes approximately one hour to complete and is eligible for one (1) Registered Environmental Health Specialist Continuing Education Unit (REHS CEU- see note 5 below). Please click <u>here</u> to register for the course. The course is also linked on the <u>LEA Training Schedule</u> webpage.

Please be advised of the following:

- 1) When you register for the training, it will take you to the CSUS training portal, please select "Solid Waste Technical Documents" to start the training. If you haven't taken a class using the CSUS training portal, you will need to create an account.
- 2) Training certificates will be emailed to individuals after completion of the training module until the vendor is able to upload the certificate to the training portal.
- 3) It is recommended that you take the entire training in one sitting. Depending on your browser settings, the training may restart if you close the browser window or lock your screen during the training.
- 4) You can click on the hyperlinks in the presentation to learn more and there are two resource documents on the CSUS training portal page that you can download for future reference.
- 5) If you have taken the Solid Waste Technical Documents training in the past 18 months, you will not be eligible for the REHS CEU.
