

## Illegal Dumping Technical Advisory Committee (IDTAC) of California

Started as a Task Force in 2006, the IDTAC provides ongoing expertise to the state and CalRecycle (Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery), assisting local, state and private agencies, nonprofits, community groups and the public by assessing the extent and cost of illegal dumping, and sharing discoveries, best practices, and strategies.

The IDTAC strategy to help combat illegal dumping is "PACE" Prevention, Abatement, Cleanup, Enforcement.

This is accomplished through the Work Plan, trainings, guidance, and other resources that are made available on the IDTAC webpages.
