## SUBJECT: Notice of Changes to Proposed Organic Waste Reduction Regulations; SB 1383.

On June 19, 2019, the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) will initiate a 15-day comment period regarding changes to the Proposed Organic Waste Reduction Regulations. The 15-day written public comment period for this rulemaking ends at 11:59 p.m. on July 3, 2019.

This 15-day comment period follows an initial 45-day public comment period that ran from January 18, 2019 to March 4, 2019, CalRecycle staff held a public hearing on the proposed regulations on March 12, 2019. After considering comments received during the initial comment period, and comments made at the public hearing, CalRecycle staff revised the proposed regulations.
