- A. Deputy Director's Report (Paulina Lawrence)
  - There was a good turnout for the virtual TTS on March 19-20, 2024.
  - Krystal Acierto was the Acting Director of CalRecycle at the time.

# B. Siting of composting facilities to meet the organic waste reduction goals (Martin Perez)

• Discussed studies and pending legislations:

**SB 1045** seeks to outline and identify sites suitable for small and medium volume composting to support the organic waste reduction goals of SB 1383.

Current law establishes a goal that statewide landfill disposal of organic waste be reduced from the 2014 level by 75% by 2025. This bill, on or before June 1, 2026, would require the Office of Planning and Research, in consultation with the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, to develop and post on the office's internet website, a technical advisory, as provided, reflecting best practices to facilitate the siting of composting facilities to meet the organic waste reduction goals. The bill would require the office to consult with specified entities throughout the development of the technical advisory. **SB 1046** seeks to prepare and certify, by January 1, 2027, a program environmental impact report that streamlines the process with which jurisdictions can develop and site small and medium compostable material handling facilities or operations, as defined, for processing organic material.

Current law authorizes the department to provide incentives to facilitate progress towards the reduction targets if the department determines that sufficient progress has not been made. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), requires a lead agency, as defined, to prepare, or cause to be prepared, and certify the completion of an environmental impact report on a project that it proposes to carry out or approve that may have a significant effect on the environment or to adopt a negative declaration if it finds that the project will not have that effect, as provided. This bill would require the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery to prepare and certify, by January 1, 2027, a program environmental impact report that streamlines the process with which jurisdictions can develop and site small and medium compostable material handling facilities or operations, as defined, for processing organic material, as specified.

Small/Medium Composting Study to be submitted to CalRecycle by June 3, 2024.

## C. Gray Container Follow-up (Martin Perez)

- City of Vernon, composed mostly of commercial businesses and few residential populaces, presents a challenge to successfully implement a three-container organic waste collection service.
- CalRecycle continues to work with the City of Vernon and would like the haulers to take the trash to a High diversion organic waste processing facility.
