TO: Glass Quality Incentive Payment Program Participants

SUBJECT: Statewide Glass Quality Incentive Payment Rates for 2025

Effective January 1, 2025, the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, Division of Recycling (CalRecycle) will implement new Statewide Glass Quality Incentive Payment (QIP) rates to ensure that only California Refund Value (CRV) glass containers collected by are claimed for QIP.

The Statewide Average QIP Rate is used to determine the amount of CRV material for purchases without a shipping report, i.e., processor-to-processor transactions. The Statewide Commingled QIP Rates are used to determine the amount of CRV material for direct purchases from curbside and dropoff or collection programs supported by a shipping report.

33.0%

2025 Statewide Commingled QIP Rate

Program Type	
Curbside	51.2%
Dropoff or Collection	54.1%
Community Service	47.2%
