Based on the findings contained in the City of Rancho Palo Verdes' (Jurisdiction) Compliance Evaluation Findings Report, and as required by Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations (14 CCR) Section 18996.2, CalRecycle is issuing the Jurisdiction a Notice of Violation (NOV) for the following requirements:

Article 3

14 CCR Section 18984.1. Three-Container Organic Waste Collection Services

The Jurisdiction failed to provide evidence of meeting all requirements for threecontainer organic waste collection services.

Article 4

14 CCR Section 18985.2. Edible Food Recovery Education and Outreach

The Jurisdiction failed to provide evidence that all required edible food recovery information was provided to edible food generators.

Article 10

14 CCR Section 18991.1. Jurisdiction Edible Food Recovery Program

The Jurisdiction failed to provide evidence of meeting all requirements for an edible food recovery program.

Article 12

14 CCR Section 18993.1. Recovered Organic Waste Product Procurement Target

The Jurisdiction failed to provide evidence that it met all requirements for recovered organic waste product procurement.

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The Jurisdiction is required to comply with the noted requirements within 90 days of the date of issuance of the NOV. Please note that if the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) finds that additional time is necessary for the Jurisdiction to come into full compliance, CalRecycle shall grant an extension for up to a total of 180 days from the date of issuance of the NOV.
