CHAPTER 8.2. Electronic Waste Recovery and Recycling

ARTICLE 2.6

Amend Section 18660.40, California Code of Regulations, title 14

### **ARTICLE 2.6: Covered Electronic Waste Recycling Fee**

Section 18660.40. Fee Amounts.

The covered electronic waste recycling fee paid by a consumer upon the purchase of a new or refurbished covered electronic device pursuant to Section 42464 of the Public Resources Code shall be the following amounts:

- (a) On or after January 1, 2026, four dollars (\$4), for each covered electronic device with a screen size of less than 15 inches measured diagonally.
- (b) On or after January 1, 2026, five dollars (\$5), for each covered electronic device with a screen size greater than or equal to 15 inches but less than 35 inches measured diagonally.
- (c) On or after January 1, 2026, six dollars (\$6), for each covered electronic device with a screen size greater than or equal to 35 inches measured diagonally.
- (d) On or after January 1, 2026, 1.5 percent of the retail sales price for each covered battery-embedded product sold for use in this state by a retailer. The covered battery-embedded waste recycling fee shall not exceed \$15.00. For the purposes of this Section, "retail sales price" shall have the same meaning as "sales price" in Section 6011 of the Revenue and Taxation Code.

- (1) There is a rebuttable presumption that a covered battery-embedded product is purchased for use in this state if either of the following is true:
  - (A) The covered battery-embedded product is purchased from a retailer physically located in this state.
  - (B) The address to which the retailer ships the purchased covered batteryembedded product is located in this state.
- (2) This Section applies to the purchase of covered battery-embedded products only.

  It does not apply to any determination regarding whether Covered Electronic

  Waste (CEW) is generated from a California Source.
