



## ◆ What's a Covered Battery-Embedded Product?

A product containing a battery from which the battery is not designed to be easily removed from the product by the user of the product with no more than commonly used household tools.

(See PRC section 42463(f)(1) and 14 CCR subsection 18660.5(a)(18), (18.5), and (22))

### Common Examples May Include:

Cell Phones, Wireless Ear Buds, Tools, Computer Accessories, Cameras, Smart Watches, Wireless Speakers/Boomboses, Electric Shavers, Personal Care Devices, Kitchen Devices, Appliances

### Excluded:

- Certain medical devices used or prescribed in healthcare settings
- Video display devices already under the Covered E-Waste Recycling Program
- Energy storage systems
- Electronic nicotine delivery systems (including electronic cannabis vaping devices)
- Motor vehicles (motor vehicles do not include motorized scooters, skateboards, or hoverboards)
