

PLASTIC MARKET DEVELOPMENT PAYMENT ELIGIBILITY FORM (CALRECYCLE 910 PMD3)

Instructions

The Plastic Market Development Payment Eligibility Form (CalRecycle 910 PMD3) must be included with every Plastic Market Development Payment Claim Form (CalRecycle 910 PMD2) submitted. Claims submitted without the Plastic Market Development Payment Eligibility Form (CalRecycle 910 PMD3) will not be processed.

1. Enter the calendar year of reporting and select the appropriate quarter of the reporting year.
2. Enter your identification number (certification number for certified entities or identification number for plastic product manufacturers).
3. Enter the facility name.
4. Enter the mailing address where payments should be mailed.
5. Enter the phone number of the business submitting the claim.
6. Enter the name of the contact person who is able to answer questions regarding the reported information.
7. Enter the contact person's email address.
8. Select your participant type.

Reclaimers- Check this box certifying that all information provided is true and correct and supports the transactions reported on the Plastic Market Development Payment Claim Form (CalRecycle 910-PMD2) for the same reporting period and acknowledging that the Department may request supporting or clarifying documentation for any data submitted.

Manufacturers- Check this box certifying that all information provided is true and correct and supports the transactions reported on the Plastic Market Development Payment Claim Form (CalRecycle 910-PMD2) for the same reporting period and acknowledging that the Department may request supporting or clarifying documentation for any data submitted.

9. Provide the signature of the authorized representative.
10. Enter the title of the authorized representative.
11. Enter the printed name of the authorized representative.
12. Enter the date the authorized representative signed the PMDP eligibility form.

SECTION A- RECLAIMER (CERTIFIED ENTITY)

Section A to be completed by a reclaimer requesting PMDP. The information in Section A (8b through 8k) must support the information submitted in Section A of the "Plastic Market Development Payment Claim Form (CalRecycle 910 PMD2)" form.

8b. For Tier 2 ONLY, enter the resin type being claimed. This must match the information entered on the Plastic Market Development Payment Claim Form (CalRecycle 910 PMD2) form.

- #2 – HDPE
- #3 – PVC
- #4 – LDPE
- #5 – PP
- #6 – PS
- #7 – OTHER

8c. Enter the weight of material purchased in tons to the 10th decimal.

8d. Enter the cost (dollar value) of the material purchased for processing.

8e. Enter the weight of the material processed to be sold to the 10th decimal.

8f. Enter the weight of material sold to the 10th decimal. The amount claimed under "8b" of Section A of the Plastic Market Development Payment Claim Form (CalRecycle 910 PMD2) must total the amounts listed here by plastic form (flake, pellet, other)

8g. Enter the price (dollar value) of the material sold to a plastic product manufacturer.

Material Purchased

8h. Enter the source of material (entity) where the material processed was purchased from. If purchased from a certified processor, the certified processor number as assigned by CalRecycle must be included.

- a. Each transaction must be listed on a separate line and items 8c through 8e must be completed.

Material Sold

8i. Select the material form (flake, pellet, other) sold to a plastic product manufacturer.

8j. Enter the name of the entity (product manufacturer) that purchased the material.

- Each transaction must be listed on a separate line and Section 8f and 8g must be completed for each transaction.

8k. Enter statement detailing the overall benefit of the material processed and sold to a California manufacturer.

SECTION B- MANUFACTURER

Section B to be completed by a plastic product manufacturer requesting PMDP. The information in Section B (9b through 9h) must support the information submitted in Section B of the "Plastic Market Development Payment Claim Form (CalRecycle 910 PMD2)" form.

- 9b. Enter the source from which the material was purchased. The certified processor number as assigned by CalRecycle must be included.
- 9c. Enter the weight of material purchased in tons to the nearest 10th decimal.
- 9d. Enter the cost (dollar value) of the material purchased.
- 9e. Enter the weight of the material used to process new plastic products to the nearest 10th decimal.
- 9f. Enter the type of product produced with the material purchased.
- 9g. Select the type of material purchased (flake, pellet, or other).
 - For each type of material purchased, Items 9b through 9f must be completed.
- 9h. Enter statement detailing the overall benefit of the material processed and sold to a California manufacturer.
