Dear Mr. Serrano,

Pursuant to §17210.3 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) Title 14, Fallbrook Recycling & Transfer (FR&T) requests that the LEA issue an emergency waiver of terms and conditions of the Fallbrook Recycling & Transfer Facility Permit #37-AA-0923 during this declared State emergency, a result of the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

The listing of the existing solid waste facilities permit terms and conditions to be waived in order to facilitate recovery and disposal of disaster debris in the event of a declared disaster or emergency is a variance in incoming tonnage from the permitted 500 tons per day to 792 tons per day. As identified in Section 4.17 Facility Capacity of the TPR, the overall facility Capacity is 792 tons per operating day

There is no remaining disposal capacity impact at the solid waste disposal facility at the time of the request as it is a Material Recovery Facility / Transfer Station.

As outlined in Section 6.5.1 Materials Separation and Sorting operations will continue as a facility-related diversion program.

FR&T has seen a dramatic increase in self-haul tonnage during this State emergency as well as increased volumes of green waste and residential tonnage. In addition, the Camp Pendleton landfill has closed several times on an irregular basis during this State emergency, with flow from this critical military installation being diverted to FR&T.

The additional tonnage can be accommodated utilizing our existing equipment and facility infrastructure. Transfer truck and trailers from our overall San Diego County operations will be sent to FR&T to ensure waste is removed within 48 hours per State law.
