Please be advised that the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), acting as the solid waste Enforcement Agency (EA) for Stanislaus County, has accepted an application package for a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) Modification for Gilton Resource Recovery Composting Facility. This public notice was prepared pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21660.3.

Project Description

Gilton Resource Recovery Composting Facility is an existing composting facility operating under a full Solid Waste Facilities Permit issued on October 30, 1992. The application package for SWFP Modification requests to decrease the permitted area from 19 acres to 8.8 acres and to update the findings, conditions, and governing documents.

EA's Determination

On June 23, 2020, the EA accepted the application for a modified SWFP submitted by the Gilton Resource Recovery/Transfer Facility. The EA's preliminary determination is that the proposed changes are such that the SWFP does not need to include further restrictions, prohibitions, mitigations, terms, conditions or other measures to adequately protect public health, public safety, ensure compliance with state minimum standards or to protect the environment, pursuant to 27 CCR 21665.
