



Carpet Stewardship Program Advisory Committee
Membership Solicitation and Instructions

Purpose

The Product Stewardship for Carpets Law (Public Resources Code (PRC) sections 42970-42983) requires the Director of the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to appoint an advisory committee to provide recommendations to a carpet manufacturer or carpet stewardship organization and to the department on carpet stewardship plans, plan amendments, and annual reports. CalRecycle is soliciting applications for a member of the environmental community to serve on the [Carpet Stewardship Program Advisory Committee](#).

This document describes the composition and duties of the advisory committee, how interested parties may apply to CalRecycle for appointment to the advisory committee, and a general timeline for the appointment process. Applications are due by June 25, 2021.

Composition of Advisory Committee

Per PRC section 42972.1(a), the advisory committee may be comprised of individuals in the environmental community, the solid waste industry, and local government representatives involved in the collection, processing, and recycling of carpet, and other interested parties. The director shall appoint one member of the advisory committee who represents carpet manufacturers and at least one member who represents either the Southern California Resilient Floor and Decorative Covering Crafts Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee or the Northern California Floor Covering Finishing Trades Institute Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee. The Speaker of the Assembly and the Senate Committee on Rules shall each appoint one additional member to the advisory committee.

Duties of Advisory Committee

- Receive a copy of carpet stewardship plans and amendments to plans no less than 30 days before a carpet stewardship organization or manufacturer submits a plan or amendment to the department.
- Receive a copy of annual reports no less than 30 days before a carpet stewardship organization or manufacturer submits the annual report to the department.
- Provide comments and recommendations to carpet stewardship organizations or manufacturers and to the department based on review of the materials.

Application Instructions

To be considered for appointment to the advisory committee as a member of the environmental community, please send a letter describing your interest and qualifications for the duties above to the CalRecycle Carpet Stewardship Team. Letters should be submitted by e-mail to carpet@calrecycle.ca.gov by June 25, 2021.

CalRecycle will accept applications from members of the environmental community through June 25, 2021. An appointment is anticipated to be announced in July 2021.
