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12. Legal Description of Facility:

This facility is located at 4388 Serrano Drive and is identified by the Assessor Parcel Number 156-210-096, Township 2 South, Range 6 West, Section 9.

13. Findings:

- a. This permit is consistent with the Riverside County Integrated Waste Management Plan, which was approved by CalRecycle (CalRecycle) and amended on September 23, 1998. The location of the facility is identified in Riverside County's Non-disposal Facility Element report (page 24), pursuant to Public Resources Code (PRC), Section (§) 50001(a).
- b. This permit is consistent with the standards adopted by CalRecycle, pursuant to PRC 44010.
- c. The design and operation of the facility is consistent with the State Minimum Standards for Solid Waste Handling and Disposal as determined by the Local Enforcement Agency, pursuant to PRC 44009.
- d. The Riverside Fire Department has determined that the facility is in conformance with applicable fire standards, pursuant to PRC, 44151.
- e. An Initial Study/Supplemental Mitigated Negative Declaration was filed with State Clearinghouse (SCH # 2021090587) and adopted by the City of Jurupa Valley on November 24, 2021. The Final Initial Study/Supplemental Mitigated Negative Declaration describes and supports the design and operation which will be authorized by the issuance of this permit. A Notice of Determination was filed with the State Clearinghouse on December 1, 2021.

14. Prohibitions:

The permittee is prohibited from accepting the following wastes:

Hazardous, radioactive, medical waste (as defined in Sections 117600-118360 of California Health and Safety Code), liquid, designated, municipal solid waste, or other wastes requiring special treatment or handling, except as identified in the Transfer Processing Report and approved amendments thereto and as approved by the Local Enforcement Agency.

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17. Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) Conditions:

- a.** The operator shall comply with all State Minimum Standards for solid waste handling and disposal as specified in Title 14 California Code of Regulations.
- b.** The operator shall maintain a log of special / unusual occurrences. This log shall include, but is not limited to, fires, explosions, the discharge or disposition of hazardous or unpermitted wastes, and significant injuries, accidents or property damage. Each log entry shall be accompanied by a summary of any actions taken by the operator to mitigate the occurrence. The log shall be available to site personnel and the LEA at all times.
- c.** Additional information concerning the design and operation of the facility shall be furnished upon request and within the time frame specified by the LEA.
- d.** A copy of this permit and the current Transfer Processing Report shall be maintained at the facility and kept available for review.
- e.** This site shall maintain a formal hazardous waste load checking program as stated in the TPR. The operator shall provide an employee training program to address the recognition, and proper response to hazardous material incidents.
- f.** Any change that would cause the design or operation of the facility not to conform to the terms and conditions of this permit is prohibited. Such a change may be considered a significant change, requiring a permit revision. In no case shall the operator implement any change without first submitting a written notice of the proposed change, in the form of a TPR amendment, to the LEA at least 180 days in advance of the change.
- g.** This permit is subject to review by the LEA and may be temporarily suspended or revoked at any time by the LEA for sufficient cause, in accordance with Division 30 of the Public Resource Code, Part 4, Chapter 4, Article 2, Sections 44305 et seq and associated regulations.
- h.** The operator shall utilize specific safety procedures and implement health and safety measures as described in the TPR.
