[Senate Bill \(SB\) 1215](#) amends the Electronic Waste Recycling Act and adds covered battery-embedded products to the CEW Recycling Program. This informal rulemaking workshop is intended to inform stakeholders about the requirements of SB 1215 and to gather stakeholder comments prior to the initiation of emergency rulemaking intended to implement, interpret, or make specific the requirements of SB 1215.

The format for the workshop will feature CalRecycle staff presentation providing opening remarks and an overview of the workshop topics, to be followed by staff facilitated open discussion.
