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## 12. Legal Description of Facility:

## 13. Findings:

- a. This permit is consistent with and identified in the City of Ventura Non-disposal Facility Element adopted by the City of Ventura City Council on July 25, 1994, pursuant to Public Resources Code (PRC), Section 50001(a)(2).
- b. This permit is consistent with the standards adopted by CalRecycle, pursuant to PRC 44010.
- c. The design and operation of the facility is consistent with the State Minimum Standards for Solid Waste Handling and Disposal as determined by the enforcement agency on June 1, 2023, pursuant to PRC 44009.
- d. The Mitigated Negative Declaration (EIR-2355) was filed with the State Clearinghouse (SCH # 2002031034) and approved by the City of San Buenaventura City Council on April 15, 2002. Notice of Determination was filed by the City with the Office of Planning and Research on June 10, 2002. The Mitigated Negative Declaration (EIR-2112) was approved by the City of San Buenaventura on June 11, 1996.
- e. The City of San Buenaventura Planning Commission through approval of Conditional Use Permit (CUP) 1000D, determined that the facility conforms to the City Comprehensive Plan, pursuant to PRC, Section 50000.5(b)
- f. The City of San Buenaventura Planning Commission through approval of CUP 1000, 1000B, 1000C, 1000D, adopted mitigation measures and monitoring/reporting program, pursuant to PRC, Section 21081.6.
- g. December 15, 2022, an addendum to previously certified MND (EIR-2355) was prepared by the City of San Buenaventura Planning Commission to reflect changes and additions of the recently approved Amendment to Use Permit, since it was determined that none of the applicable conditions required a subsequent EIR or negative declaration. Notice of Determination was filed by the City on February 23, 2023.

## 14. Prohibitions:

The permittee is prohibited from accepting the following wastes:

1. Liquid waste (greater than 50% moisture)
2. Hazardous Wastes (as defined in Health and Safety Code, Division 20, Chapter 6.5, Section 25117, and Title 22, California Code of Regulations, Division 4.5.)
3. Medical Wastes (defined in Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 14, Section 117690.
4. Special wastes (defined in CCR Title 22)
5. Designated wastes
6. Septic tank pumping or chemical toilet wastes
7. Dead animals
8. Regulated or Contaminated Soils
9. Medical Waste (defined in Section 117600-118360 of the Health and Safety Code)

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## 17. Enforcement Agency (EA) Conditions:

- a. The operator shall comply with all State Minimum Standards for solid waste handling and disposal as specified in Title 14, California Code of Regulations
- b. This facility shall comply with all terms and conditions specified in this permit.
- c. Additional information concerning the design and operation of the facility shall be furnished upon request and within the time specified by the LEA.
- d. This permit is subject to review by the LEA and may be suspended, revoked, or revised at any time of sufficient cause.
- e. The LEA reserves the right to suspend or modify waste receiving and handling operations when deemed necessary due to an emergency, a potential health hazard, or the creation of a public nuisance.
- f. Any change that would cause the design or operation of the facility not to conform to the terms and conditions of this permit is prohibited. The operator shall notify the LEA at least 180 days in advance of any proposed significant changes in design operation.
- g. A copy of this permit and the Transfer/Processing report shall be maintained at the facility.
- h. The operator shall notify the LEA of any breakdown of the facility baler, and/or conveyor systems of more than eight hours duration.
- i. The operator shall maintain all necessary permits current. Copies of all permits shall be made available to the LEA upon request.
