Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) staff has reviewed the Minor Waste Tire Facility Permit (WTFP) application package, dated August 12, 2024, and received by CalRecycle on August 12, 2024, for Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority, located at 1104 Madison Lane in Salinas.
