AB 341 – 75 Percent Recycling Goal

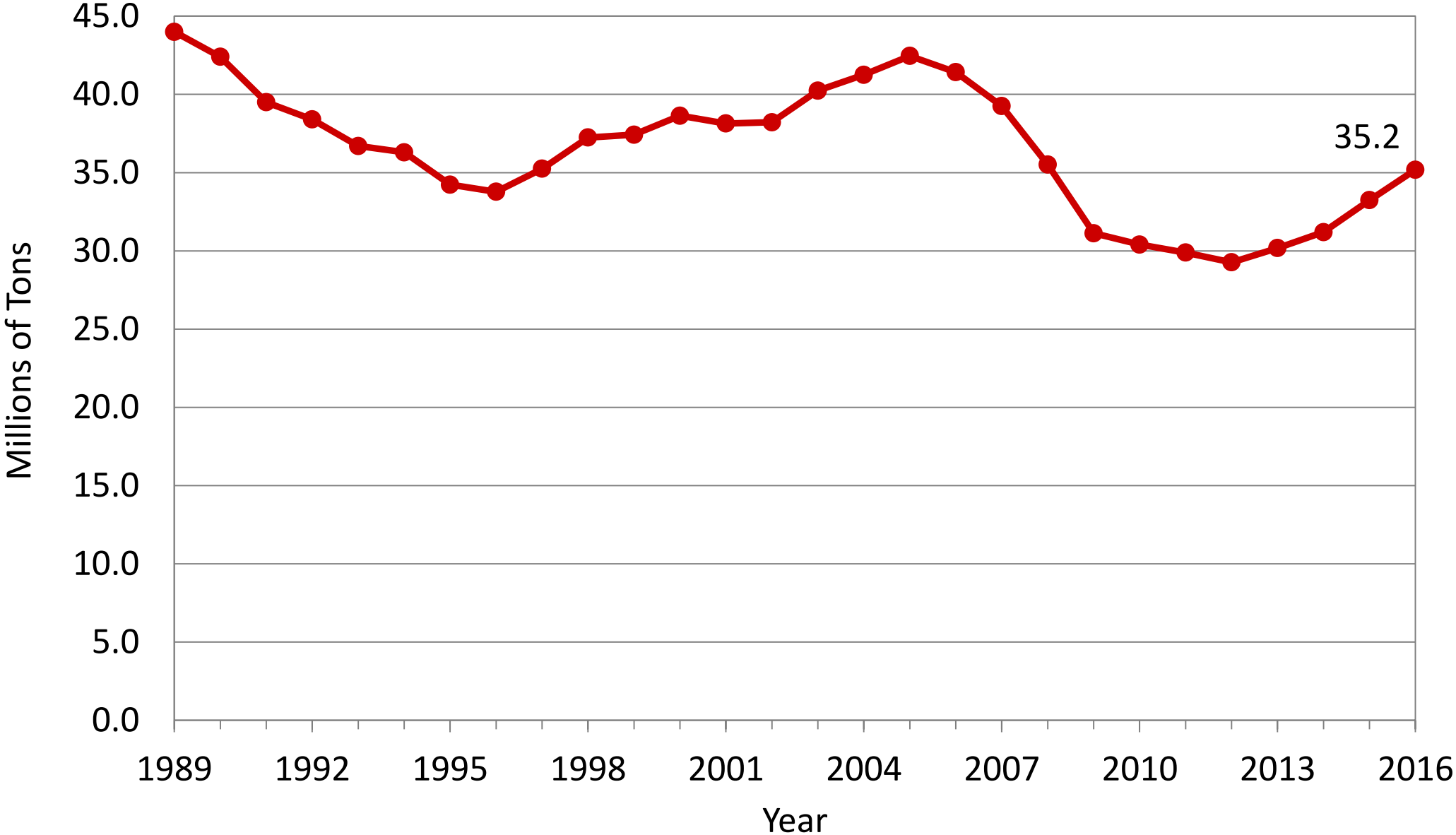
Disposal includes:

- Exported to landfill

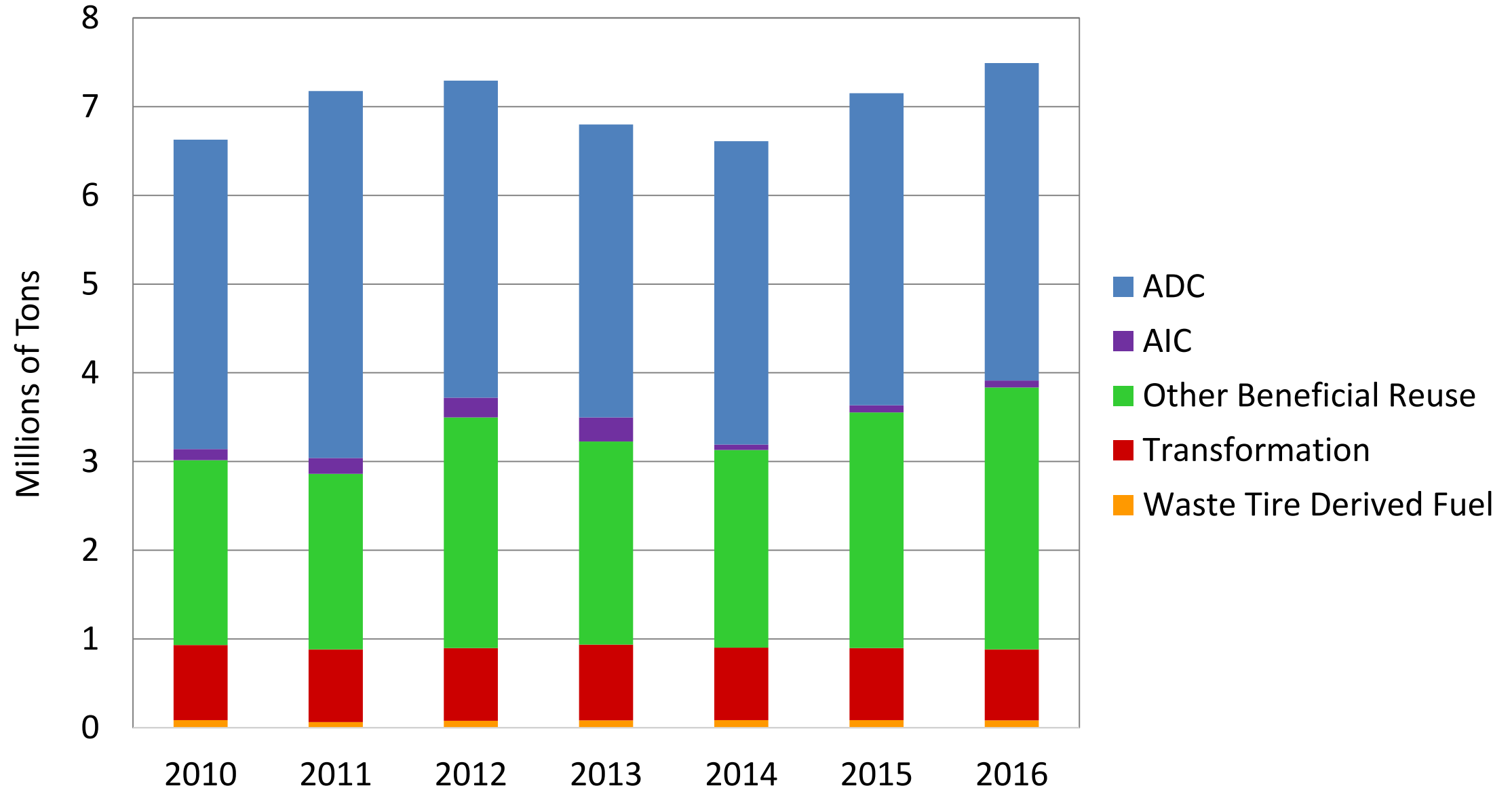
Disposal-related also includes:

- Waste-derived fuel

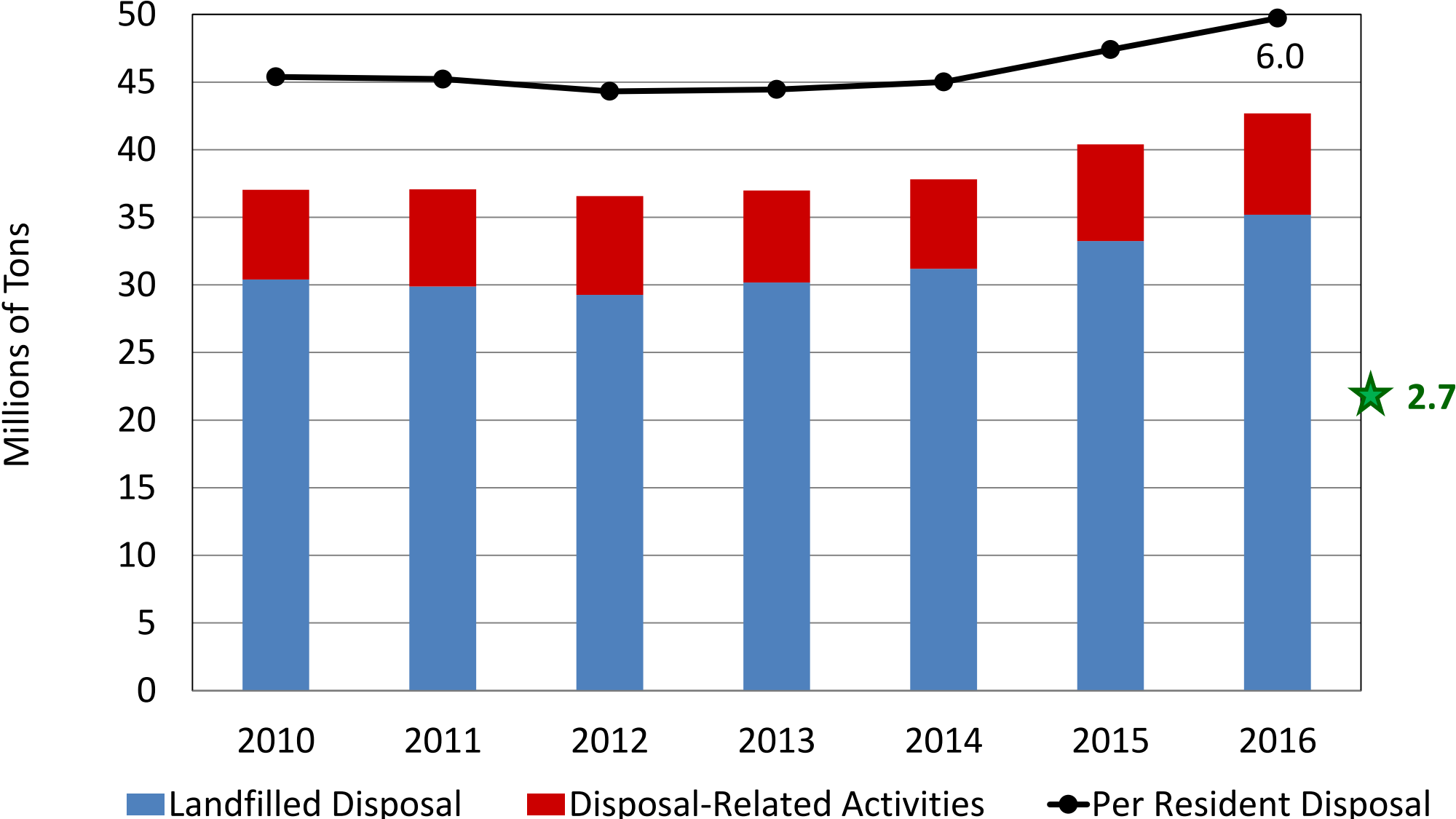
Statewide Disposal



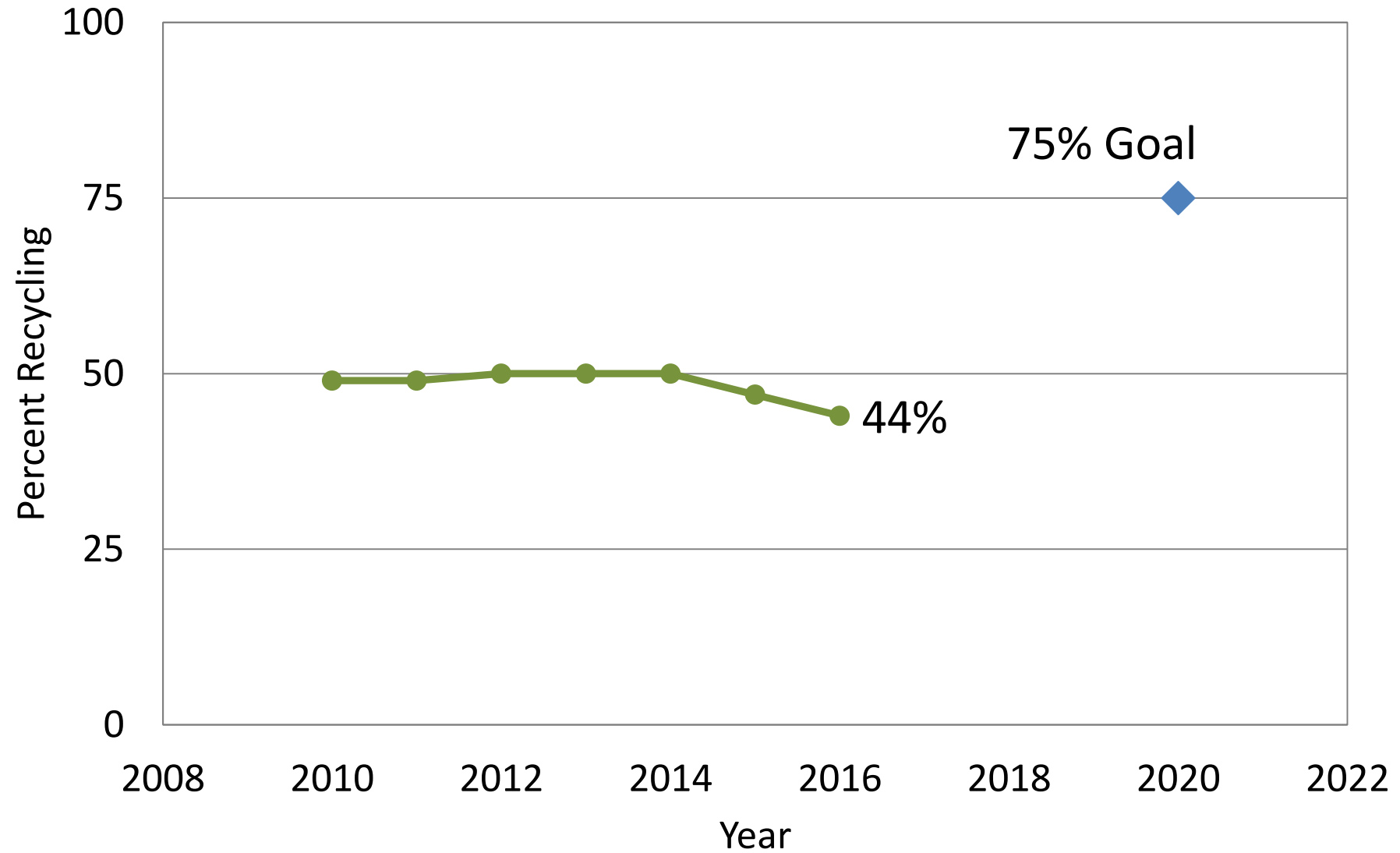
Statewide Disposal-Related Tons



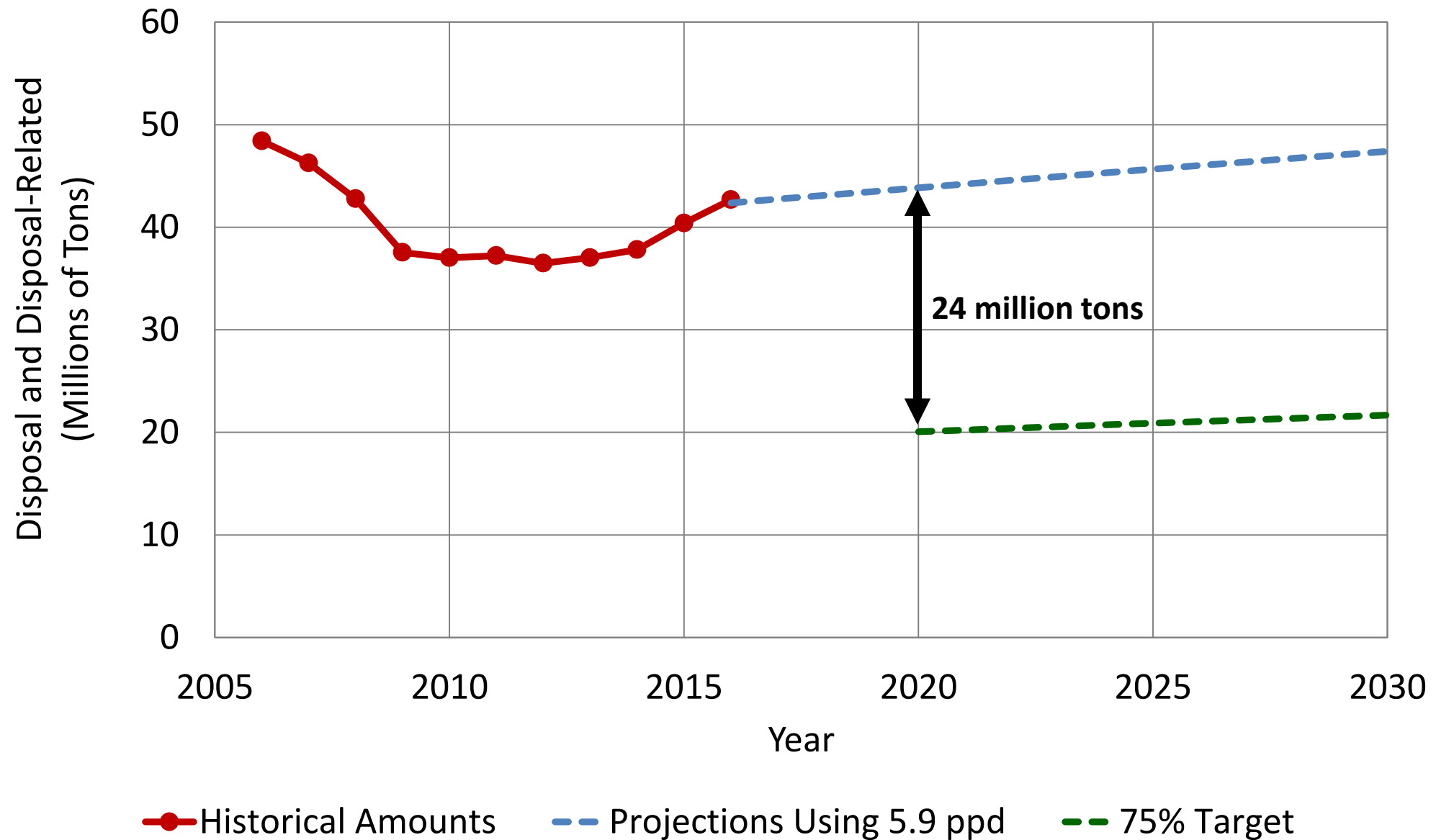
Statewide Per Capita Disposal
