Recycling and Organics Recycling Guide for Businesses

If you are receiving this, you have been identified as subject to California's mandatory recycling laws.

Mandatory Recycling and Organics Recycling (MCR, MORe, and SB 1383)

- Businesses, including public entities, are required to label, recycle, and periodically inspect containers for contamination.*
- Businesses are required to educate employees on proper recycling.

AB 827: Educating and Involving Customers to Achieve California's Recycling Goals

• MCR- and MORe-covered businesses must provide recycling and organics containers at front-of-house to collect waste generated by customers from products they purchase and consume on the premises. These containers must be placed adjacent to trash containers.

AB 827 Requirements

- AB 827 requires collection containers at front-of-house to be visible, easily accessible, and clearly marked.
- This law targets businesses that sell products meant for immediate consumption.
- Full-service restaurants do not have to provide properly labeled containers for patrons but must provide properly labeled containers next to trash containers for employees to separate post-consumer recyclables and organics for customers.
