



- Purchased new refrigeration units, vehicles, and other equipment to support distribution partners
- · Added staff and provided training for inventory software

### **About Food Forward**

Food Forward recovers produce from:

- Backyard fruit trees
- Orchards
- Farmers markets
- · The produce industry, including growers, distributors, and the downtown Los Angeles Wholesale Produce Market

Food Forward gets an average 270,000 people a day their daily recommend servings of fruits and vegetables by partnering with hunger relief agencies across:

- 13 California counties
- Neighboring states and tribal lands

- Abound Food Care, previously Waste Not OC Coalition, is building a national movement of nonprofit, public, and private partners to eliminate food waste and food insecurity.
- They turn bulk food donations into ready-to-heat-and-eat meals for Californians in need.
- Partners with buyers, processors, distributors, operators, waste haulers, jurisdictions, and food recovery groups to boost staffing, cold storage capacity, and supplies for food recovery kitchens.




